- Carefully study the piece. How does the artist use elements and principles such as color, shape, balance, and light to create the composition?
- With **only** 3 or 4 items you find in or around your home, recreate the image! (*You may need to use an extra person or two from your home too!*)
- Take a photo of your recreated masterpiece. Try, as best as you can with the items you find, to copy/duplicate how the artist used line, color, balance, etc.
- * As you can tell, you may need someone to take it for you. Please, no selfies.
